SCHOOL HOLIDAY PROVISION: Our holiday camps are designed & tailored for children with Special Educational Needs and Disabilities. From baking to sports, sensory activities to soft play we have it all.



PHYSICAL EDUCATION LESSONS: Our team of expert inclusive educators provide Primary PE Lessons that every child can take part in. Lessons that put inclusion at the heart of the plan.

WORK EXPERIENCE & EMPLOYMENT: Individuals with a disability are almost twice as likely to be unemployed compared to adults without a disability. So we are providing high quality workplace experiences for individuals with a disability.

WHY WE DO IT?

- It is three times more costly to bring up a child with disability.
- Parents are less likely to be in work because of their caring responsibilities and a lack of childcare.
- 1 in 7 families with a disabled child cannot afford to feed themselves due to the additional costs associated with looking after a child with a disability.
- 1 in 4 families cannot afford the specialist equipment or care for their child with a disability.

say finding childcare for disabled children is more difficult compared to others.

82%

of those who do use childcare pay above average, with a minimum of £5 extra per hour for their child.

39% don't use childcare because it is too expensive.

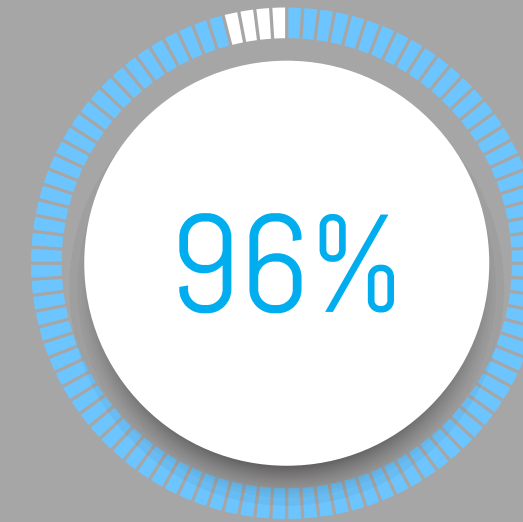
