Ensure you have strong behaviour management within all PE lessons and clubs, following the schools behaviour policy and Entries morals and values.

You must be professional in all your interactions with children, parents and colleagues in schools.

Communicate effectively and appropriately with children, parents/guardians, and other staff members, knowing that every individual may need personalised care and communication.

4. Deliver with Safety

Safeguarding of the children is absolutely paramount. You must ensure all children are safe and secure at all times and you are aware of the safeguarding procedures in place both within schools and wrap-around care / holiday club settings.

You must be familiar with and follow all company policies and procedures.

Key responsibilities:

- Plan and deliver inclusive sessions - Develop and execute lesson plans that cater to a wide range of abilities, ensuring that each child can participate and benefit from the activities.
- Assessment and adaptation - assess your delivery and lessons termly to make necessary adjustments to meet the diverse needs of all students.
